MARK FOERSTER IS MAKING HIS DIRECTORIAL DEBUT WITH THIS PRODUCTION, A LOGICAL PROGRESSION FROM HIS LAST APPEARANCE AS THE "BIG MAN" IN "A NICE PLACE TO VISIT."

RON SAUTTER RON MAKES HIS DIRECTING DEBUT WITH C.C.T. AS ONE OF THE CO-DIRECTORS OF THIS EVENING'S PLAY. NOT NEW TO THE TIBBITS STAGE, RON HAS APPEARED IN 18 SUMMER STOCK PRODUCTIONS HERE AT TIBBITS AND WAS THE PRODUCER OF THE 1982 SUMMER SEASON. HE IS CURRENTLY IN THE PROCESS OF FORMING A COLDWATER COMMUNITY CHORUS AND IS TEACHING PRIVATE VOICE LESSONS AT BOSS-SHEA MUSIC.

KEN ANDREWS COMES TO C.C.T. FROM DETROIT, MI. HE CURRENTLY WORKS FOR WTVB/WNWN DURING THE EVENING AS "NIGHTTIME BROADCAST SUPERVISOR" AND DOES THE WEATHER ON THE "MUSHMOUTH" SHOW. FUTURE AMBITIONS INCLUDE GROWING A LONG WHITE BEARD, BEING SEATED ON A MOUNTAIN TOP EATING UNFLAVORED GELATIN ("IT'S GOOD FOR THE NAILS") AND RECITING JOHN LENNON RECORDS BACKWARDS.

KATHY STUEVER FOERSTER THE EVER-SO-PROFESSIONAL CEIL ADAMS IN "MISS REARDON..." IS APPEARING ON THE TIBBITS STAGE FOR THE FIRST TIME. A GRADUATE OF M.S.U. WITH DEGREES IN HUMAN ECOLOGY AND CONTINUING EDUCATION, SHE'S A FAMILY LIVING AGENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY'S COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE. A FIRM BELIEVER IN THE "CASTING COUCH," FOERSTER GOT HER ROLE IN "MISS REARDON..." BY SLEEPING WITH AT LEAST ONE OF THE CO-DIRECTORS.

MARTY CRAIG FIRST APPEARED AT TIBBITS AS KAREN DASH IN "PLAZA SUITE," AND YEARS BEFORE THAT AS AUNT MARTHA IN "ARSENIC AND OLD LACE," HER HIGH SCHOOL PRODUCTION. MARTY TAUGHT AT THE COLDWATER PRESCHOOL NURSERY FOR 14 YEARS, BUT SAWE THAT UP TO MANAGE HER NEW BUSINESS, CRAIG HALLMARK.

KEVIN IRELAND THIS IS KEVIN'S FIRST APPEARANCE ON STAGE AS AN ACTOR, OR READER IN THIS CASE, ALTHOUGH HE HAS BEEN ON THE STAGE OF THE TIBBITS SEVERAL TIMES AS MASTER OF CEREMONIES FOR THE BRANCH COUNTY JUNIOR MISS PROGRAM. HIS ACTING EXPERIENCE TO THIS POINT HAS BEEN DONE IN RADIO COMMERCIALS SOMETHING HE DOES ALMOST EVERY DAY.
