JAN ADLER - During the three years Jan has spent with C.C.T., she has performed in "The Good Doctor", filled the positions of stage manager, C.C.T. Secretary and has done much work with props.

CHRISTINE WALLACE COLBECK - Christine is making her C.C.T. acting debut in this production. Previously, she has been producer, costumer and stage manager in other productions of C.C.T.

MARTY CRAIG - A seasoned and capable performer, Marty has appeared in not less than seven recent C.C.T. productions. She enjoys helping with sets and costumes when she isn't in front of the lights.
