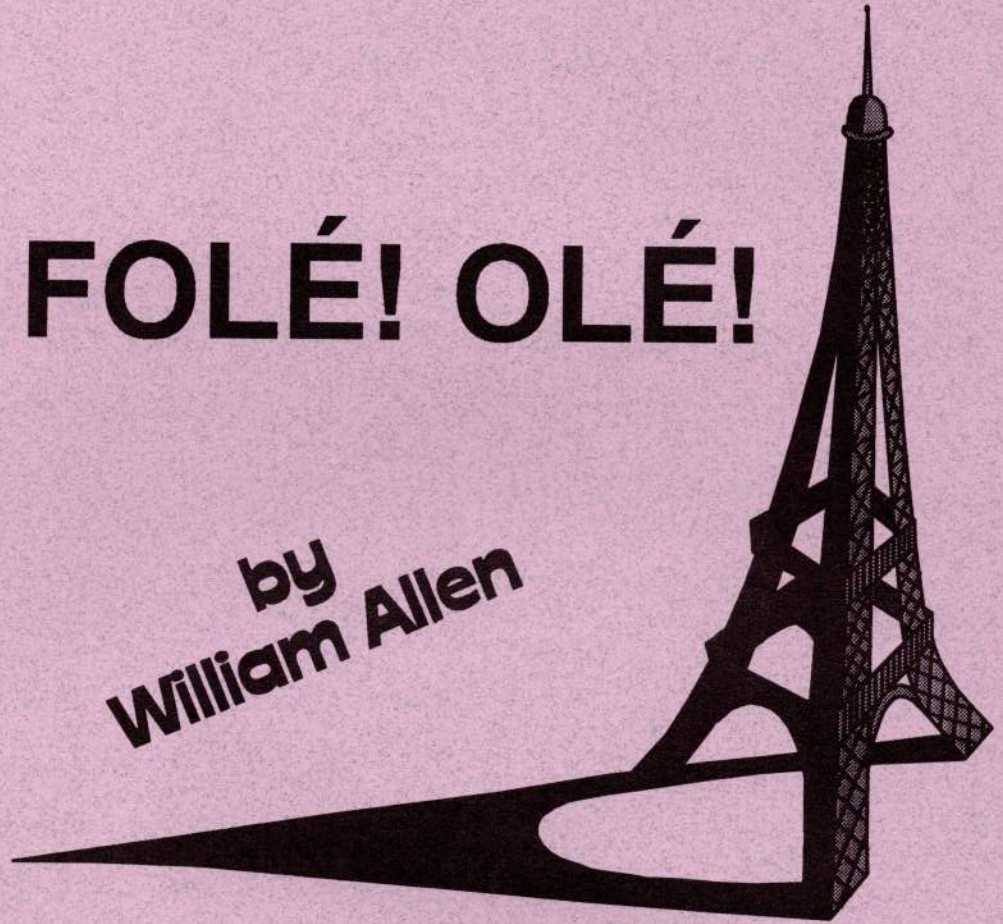

About the Robert J. Pickering Award for Playwriting Excellence

The presentation of FOLE! OLE!, by William Allen, marks the 21st production to win this prestigious award.

When the award was initiated in 1984, the three Pickering shows produced in 1979, 1981 and 1984 were the first recipients.

Beginning in 1985, the actual award was presentation of the manuscript. To most new authors this is better than money! In 1987 monetary awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place were added.

The award is now international and enjoys an outstanding reputation. Several winning scripts have been published. CCT is proud to be the only amateur theatre group in Michigan to offer this program.
